Application Details:

Proposals require a brief description of the art work, drawings or schematics of the proposed project (floor plan available upon request), a current artist statement, resume of past exhibitions if available, digital images of relevant work, and a reason why you are applying to the AMproject. Note that all material will not be returned so no slides or actual art work, please.

Selection Process:

The AMproject is a contemporary space that shows contemporary work. All work will be selected by Seth Hoercher and Jeffrey Mohr. Projects will be selected based on several different criteria.

1. Work must be relevant for the space. This is not a typical white wall gallery and typical work will not be selected. Consider the space to guide the work.
2. Work of all types will be under consideration. Please note that all video equipment must be provided by the artist as well as any special lighting needs.
3. Greasing the wheels of the curator is a very real and possible way to avoid all above details of the process, but be sure to be professional about this, fraudulent attempts will be noticed and dismissed.
4. Since this is an alternative space think accordingly, pretty pictures and nice paintings probably are not the best things to submit, but if you think so surprise us with why.

Selected Artist's Receive:

Show schedules will be loosely decided by the gallery with consideration to the scope and schedule of the artist. All shows will have custom show cards provided as well as posters all funded by the gallery. All shows also include basic refreshments and snacks for the guest of the event.
